

ODYSSEY GRADES 3-6 SUMMER READING CHOICE BOARD

Directions: Finish two activities to complete your choice board.

Make a COLLAGE! Find pictures from magazines or online to create a collage that represents what happened in your story. Try to find pictures to illustrate the characters, problem/solution, setting and events. Make sure you label these on your collage.

1

Write a short poem about your favorite character. Make it 12 lines long with six rhyming words describing what your character looks like or the personality of the character.

Write a reflective journal entry from the point of view of one of the main characters. Describe how you feel. This journal entry may be something they wrote before, during or after the book's events. Remember that the character's thoughts and feelings are very important in a journal entry. 3

Create a timeline of events from your book. Include important dates, character introductions, conflicts and resolutions. Include images to represent each event.

Compose a song to retell the events or share the theme of your story. Record your song and prepare to read or perform this for your parents or class.

Design a detailed scene using crayons, colored pencils or paint of an exciting part of the book or your favorite chapter. Be sure to include all of the important characters, and exciting events.

Write a 1-paragraph summary of your novel. Include the major events and an illustration. You may write/draw it or create a PowerPoint slide to add a book cover image.

7

Write an **alternative ending** to the story. Write 2 paragraphs that describe a different ending for your story.
