

How to Download and Use the BPS FOCUS App

Troubleshooting Guide starts on page 3

The free BPS FOCUS mobile app will allow parents to quickly monitor a child's academic progress and view assignments, grades and attendance throughout the year. This app is a companion to the BPS Mobile App that provides emergency notifications and messages to parents. Both apps are available through the Android and Apple stores. Please note that Brevard Public Schools is not able to assist users with personal devices.

Setup Mobile App

- STEP 1: Go to Android or Apple App store and search for BPS FOCUS
- STEP 2: Download BPS Focus Mobile app






Parents who have already created their Focus Parent Portal account online can proceed to Step 1.

Parents who **have not** yet created their Focus Parent Portal account need to obtain a PIN number from their child's school and review the directions located at

<u>https://tinyurl.com/gradebookBPS</u> to create their account before they're able to log in to the mobile app.

- STEP 1: Click Parent Login
- STEP 2: Enter your Focus Parent Portal account credentials
- STEP 3: Click Parent Login to login





Overview:

Get an overview of each child's schedule, attendance, and



grades.

Student News:

View any upcoming assignments, whether any assignments were late or what letter grade the child received for the assignment.

Planner:

View what is assigned to the child in the next 7 days.









Menu

By selecting the 3 bars at the top left (the Menu page) you have access to each of the Overview, News, Links and Messenger pages. You can adjust some settings using the directions below. The option to Logout of the Community App is located on the bottom of the Menu page on your device.



Settings:

Allows you to enable School News and Social Media to be updated on information provided by the school or district.


School News:

This setting allows school administrators to send important messages to parents using the app. It is turned on automatically for any schools your children attend. You can enable additional schools if you wish to receive any public messages they send.

Social Media:

Parents will see social media feeds from school(s) that their child(ren) attend by default. These include postings on the school website homepage. Some schools also provide Facebook and Twitter feeds. Parents can turn these feeds on or off as desired and can select additional schools to follow.








Student Overview

To access the teacher web page, click on the course title in the student overview screen. If the teacher has a webpage linked to that class, the page will display.



Teacher Webpage

The news tab displays posts from the teacher webpage. The links tab is where the resources links are posted from the teacher webpage.
